The Saskatchewan Environmental Society (SES) offers high quality energy conservation awareness and action projects. Through education and demonstration SES provides tools, information, and references to financial resources for building retrofits and other energy saving activities. Our presenters are knowledgeable in child and adult education, and energy conservation technologies and skills.



Choose from any of the programs below and begin to save energy and money today!

Destination Conservation Saskatchewan

Applicable to: Schools, grades K-12. Students, teachers, custodians, and parents.

Provides: Practical, student-driven, activity-based program that brings environmental education alive in our schools. Focuses on saving energy, conserving water and reducing waste.

Time Frame: Three-year program that consists of workshops, year end activities and teacher resource manuals.

Costs: SES partners with sponsors SaskEnergy and SaskPower to present this program. The remaining cost of \$250 per school per year is paid by the school, or school division.

Building Operator Training Program

Applicable to: Custodial and building maintenance staff in schools, health care facilities and businesses.

Provides: Technical information, energy conservation principles and retrofit ideas that can save on energy and maintenance costs while helping the environment.

Time Frame: Fives modules are presented (HVAC, Lighting, Electrical, Water, Waste) which can be covered in two full days, or four half days.



Costs: Dependent on time frame chosen. Typically \$1,000 per half day or \$1,350 per full day plus \$30 per participant. Bulk rates available.

Energy Awareness

Applicable to: All staff and volunteers of any office, health care facility, school, or other organizations.

Provides: Workplace training offering specific skills and techniques on how to conserve energy and reduce costs at work and at home. Fosters employee teamwork in reducing energy consumption, conserving resources and reducing waste.

Time Frame: Two hour session, but can be tailored to suit clients' needs.

Costs: \$500 per session, \$15 per person attending, plus travel costs. Bulk rates available.


Saskatchewan Environmental Society/Affinity Credit Union Energy Conservation for Non-Profit Organizations

Applicable to: Any non-profit organization within Saskatoon and the jurisdiction of Affinity Credit Union

Provides: Energy assessment and technical assistance for potential upgrades/retrofits.

Time Frame: Period of time for walk through plus presentation of results.

Costs: Free, plus potential access to loans for upgrades.
