### **PETER PREBBLE JOINS ENVIRONMENTAL SOCIETY LEADERSHIP TEAM**

The Saskatchewan Environmental Society is very pleased to announce that Peter Prebble has re-joined the Society's workforce. As Director, Energy and Water Policy, Mr. Prebble will be working in collaboration with Ann Coxworth, SES's Program Coordinator and Michelle Heiser, SES's Watershed Protection Programmer. In a combination of salaried and volunteer roles, Peter's major focus areas over the next several months will be integrated water resource management, an environmentally sustainable energy strategy for Saskatchewan, oil sands and nuclear issues.

Peter Prebble has spent a total of 16 years as a member of the Saskatchewan Legislature. During that time he has served as the cabinet minister responsible for the Saskatchewan Water Corporation and as Legislative Secretary for Energy Conservation and Renewable Energy. So he knows both water and energy issues intimately. In 2006 Peter announced he would not be running in the fall 2007 provincial election. We are delighted that he is resuming a leadership role with the Saskatchewan Environmental Society.
